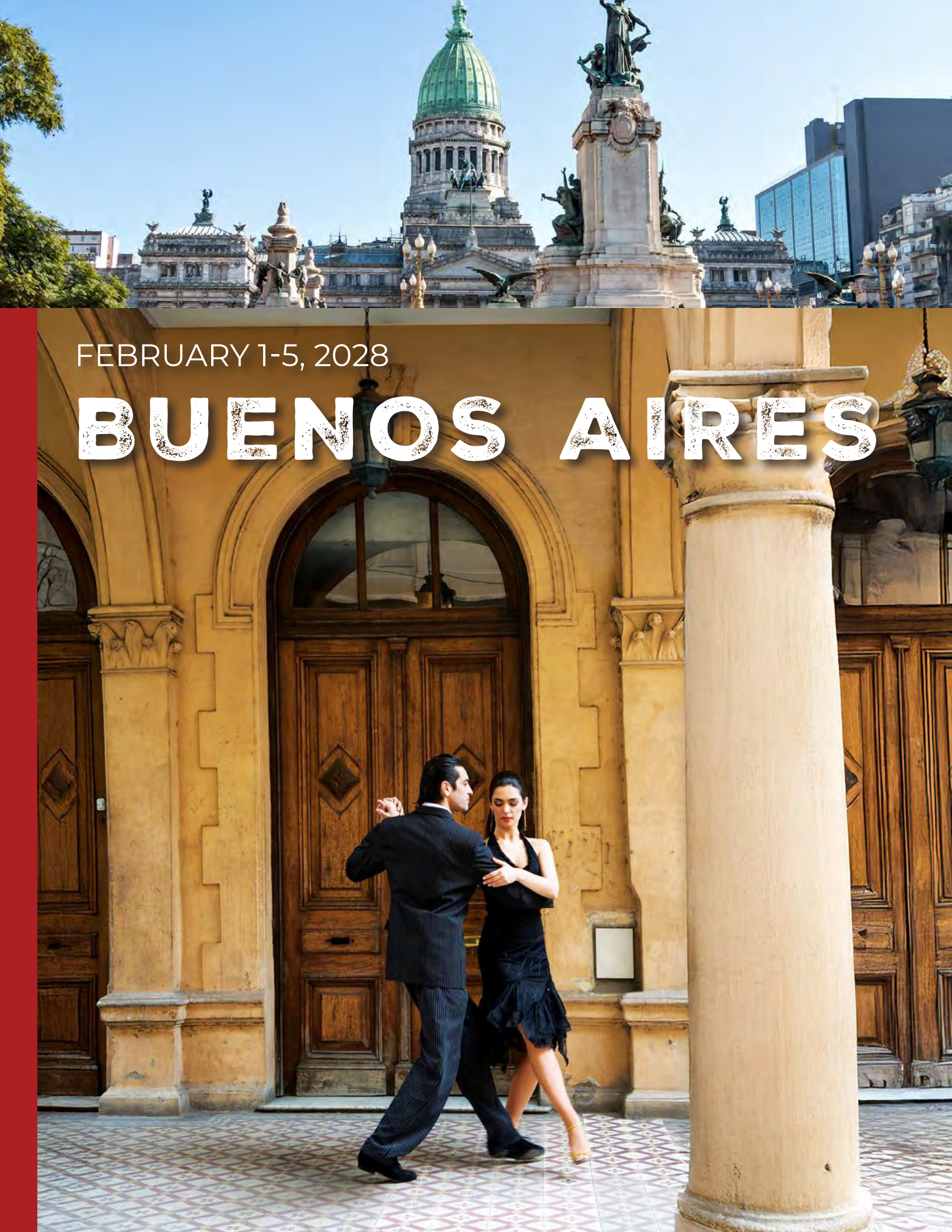

When there is nothing left in the world, imagination will remain in Buenos Aires.

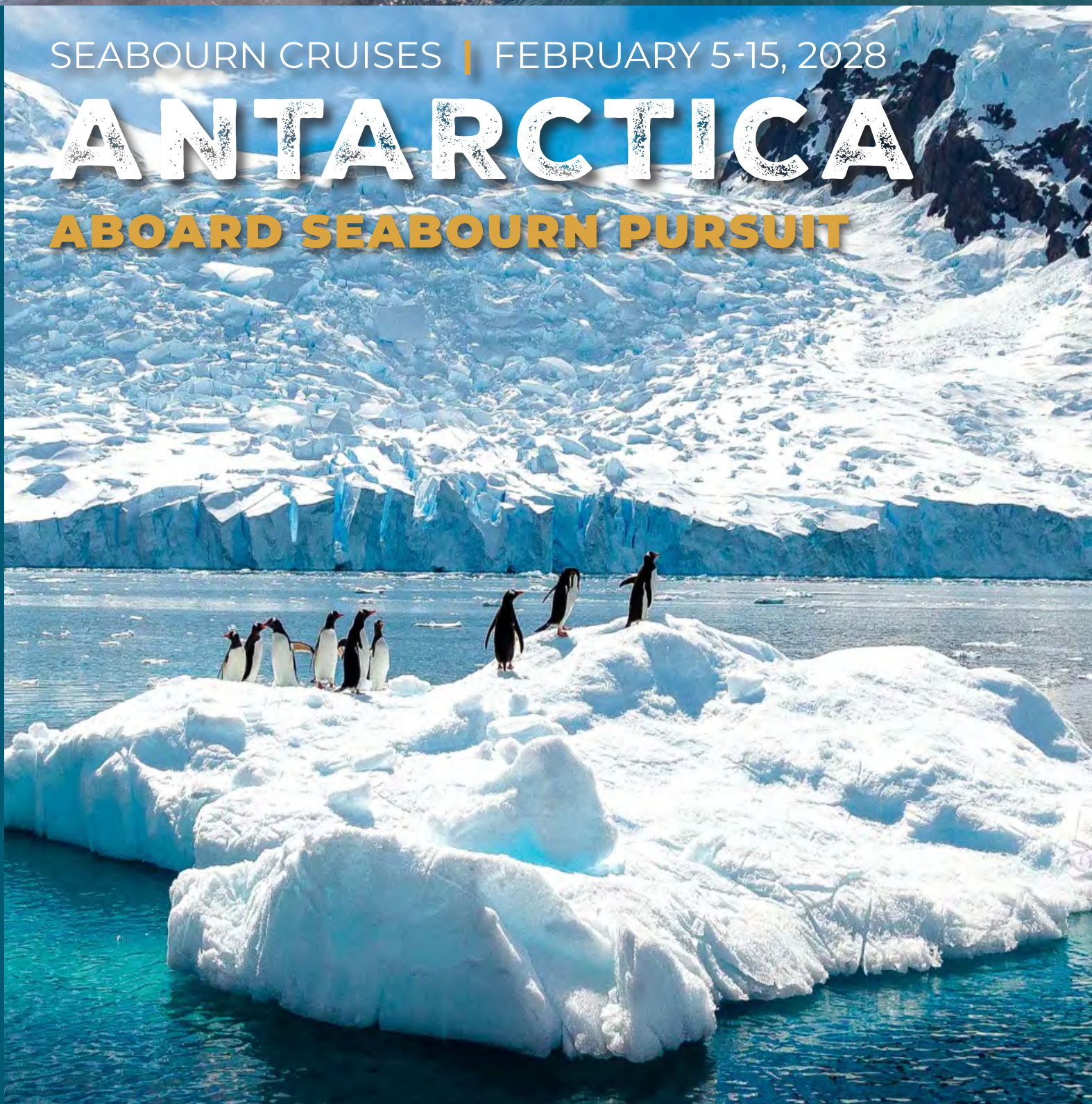

Take your time getting to know the ship and preparing for our adventures ahead.

SEABOURN ANTARCTIC EXPERIENCE

Arrive 7:00 AM | Depart 5:00 pm

Each day in Antarctica is unique and with no fixed itinerary, options for exploration are endless. Depending on weather, ice conditions and reported wildlife distribution during your voyage, your Expedition Leader will craft a bespoke adventure, guided by tides and instinct for you to discover. Upon arrival, we'll have five full days in Antarctica to explore and enjoy everything this part of the world has to offer.

At the very edge of the world, hop into the Zodiacs with an Expedition team driver-naturalist for a journey like no other. Here, in the vast desolation of Antarctica, we'll explore among iceberg giants dwarfed by behemoth tidewater glaciers.

Zodiacs provide an astounding vantage point from which to experience this icy wonderland. Seascapes of wild blue, punctuated and pierced by mesmerizing ice forms sculpted by the Southern Ocean, captivate even those most widely traveled. Icebergs drift aimlessly, sheltering seals and penguins from killer whales on the prowl.

Some days may include landings. Whether a hike up to a glacier viewpoint or a short walk along a beach to admire penguins, the Expedition team guides your steps and your processing of this extraordinary moment. Both ashore and aboard the ship, biologists, geologists, glaciologists, and historians interpret this remarkable continent that teems with the hardest of life.

Antarctica has this mythic weight. It resides in the collective unconscious of so many people, and it makes this huge impact, just like outer space.

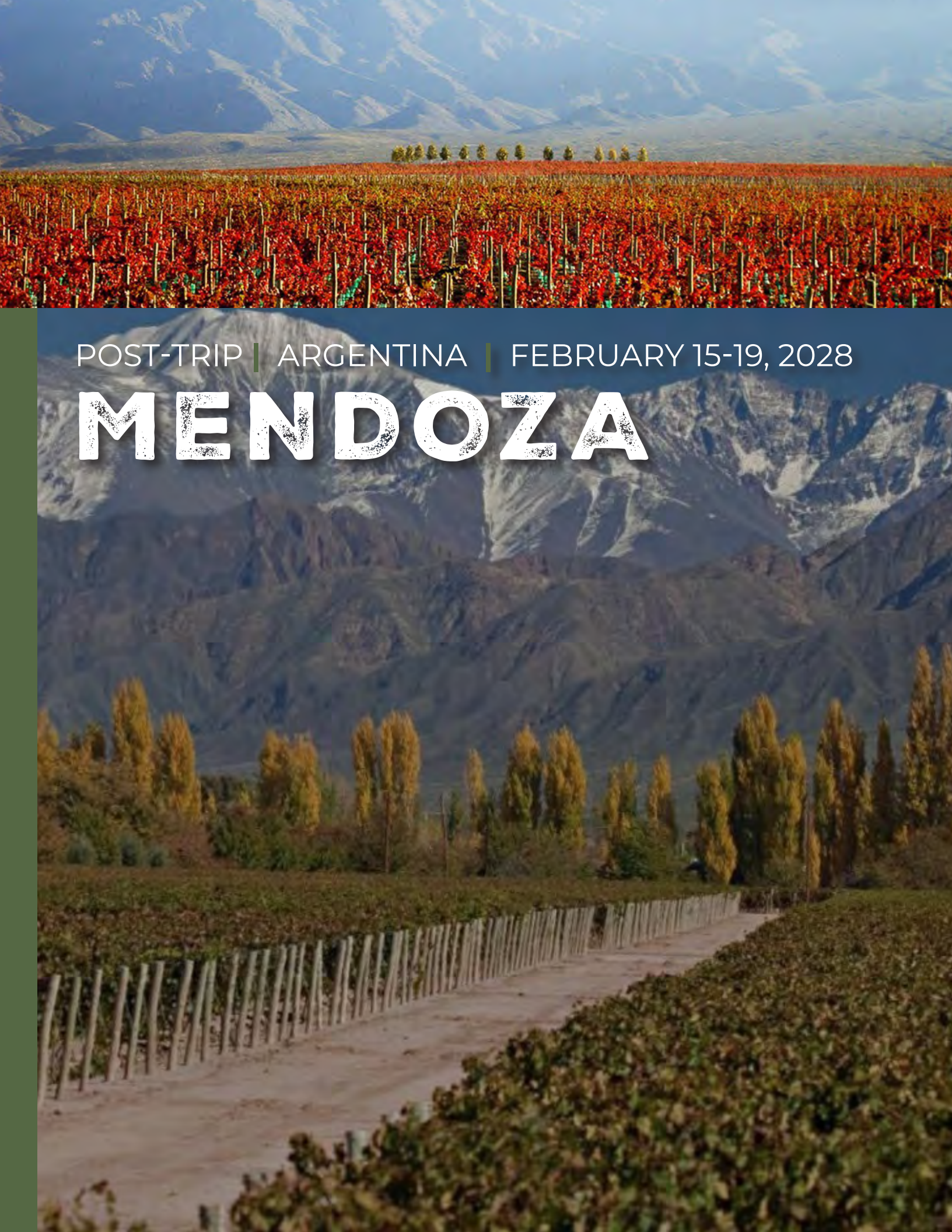

MENDOZA



Set at the foothills of the Andes, Mendoza is defined by elemental beauty and a quiet confidence shaped by land, water, and light. Founded in the 16th century and rebuilt after a devastating earthquake, the city is a testament to resilience and reinvention. Tree-lined avenues, wide boulevards, and shaded plazas form an oasis in the desert, sustained by an ingenious network of irrigation canals that date back to Indigenous and colonial times. Framed by snowcapped peaks and endless vineyards, Mendoza feels both grounded and expansive, a place where nature is not a backdrop but a constant presence.

Beyond the city, the rhythm of life unfolds in its wine regions. Luján de Cuyo is traditional and storied, Maipú rooted in family-run bodegas and heritage, and the Uco Valley bold and contemporary, where cutting-edge architecture meets high-altitude drama. Together, they form the heart of Argentina's wine culture, one that balances craftsmanship with innovation and reverence for the land.

During our visit, we will enjoy Mendoza through long lunches paired with exceptional Malbec, candlelit dinners in the vineyards and days shaped by the outdoors.

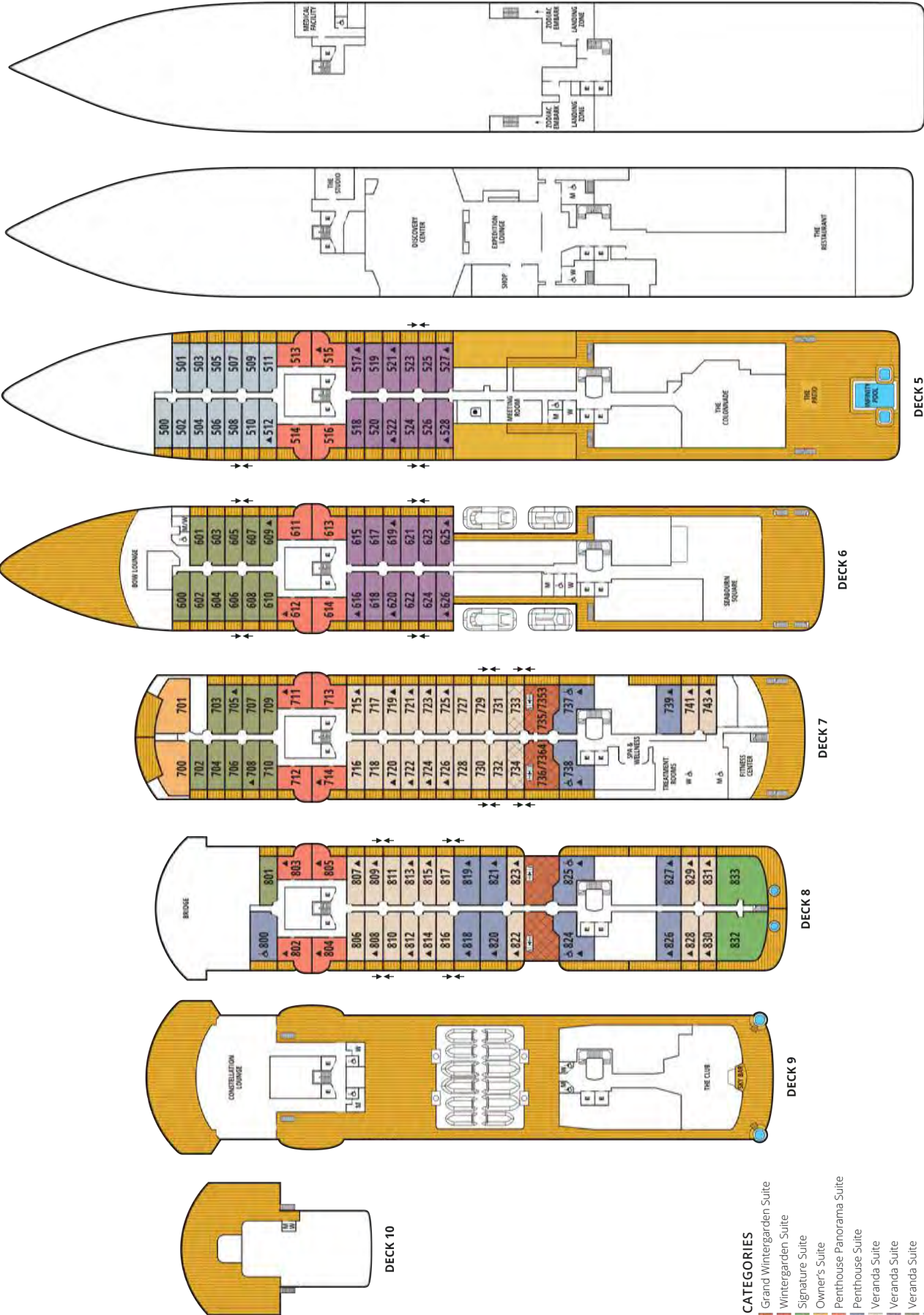

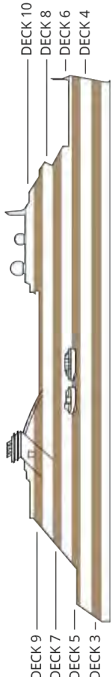

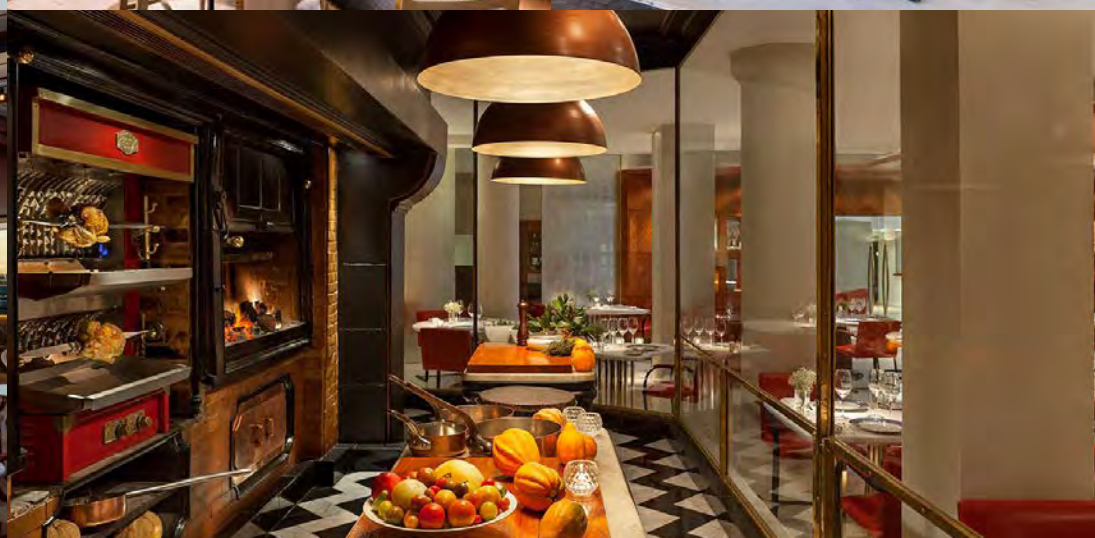
